Content Below: Short Notice in “laymans lingo” on the following Komodo Daemon update - ***"To officially bring the new Notary Node operators into the network, an upgrade to the Komodo daemon to version 0.6.0 will be activated on June 14, 2020 at block height 1,922,000. The upgrade is mandatory for all miners, exchanges, wallet providers, and other individuals running a full node. Please be sure to update prior to June 14."*** And this notice details how this Komodo Daemon update/change on the 14th June 2020, will affect existing ilien Agama wallet users, and this includes all Agama wallet versions up to and including Agama version 0.6.1; And in particular this notice is directed to those users running their existing Agama wallet in NATIVE mode for any komodoplatfrom asset coin, including ILN:

Hi Folks,

As you may be aware, Verus is no longer supporting their Agama wallet app for upgrades, as they have released their own Verus multi coin wallet recently; ILN is not currently listed on the new Verus wallet just yet, but should be in the near future; On the 10th June 2020 – it became apparent that due to the Komodo Daemon upgrade referred to above, that the current Agama wallet app required an upgrade to allow users who use Agama NATIVE wallet mode, to incorporate the Komodo Daemon changes. due to the planned introduction of the newly elected komodo notary node operators into the komodoplatfrom network(s) on Sunday the 14th June 2020; This annual introduction of newly elected komodo notary node operators is referred to by komodoplatfrom, as a seasonal event;

These upgrades for current Agama Native wallet users have been packed into a new Agama wallet release for Windows OS, MacOS and LinuxOS – and the pack is called “Agama v0.6.1 season 4”; **This upgrade is essential for Agama Native wallet users;** As is the norm, this version for each OS has been tested, adware/malware checked - listing any false positives, and sha files are included to ensure the integrity of the upgraded files; As with all Agama releases the usual disclaimer applies, for “as is software”; We would like to thank Oink for

his kind efforts in putting this Agama upgrade pack together for the ilien community, at such short notice;

For current Agama Lite wallet users – the upgrade is not essential for all OS versions of Agama v0.6.1 - as Chainmakers (the ilien communities blockchain and server, servicers) will be upgrading the ilien electrum servers on Saturday the 13th June 2020 to incorporate the Komodo Daemon upgrade requirement; *Note: most of the new ilien coin users generally appear to utilise Agama Lite wallets;*

Some points to note, regarding Verus Coin use in the Agama wallet app:

1. For users running **Verus Coin in Lite mode** in their current Agama v0.6.1 wallet release – **Verus coin will continue to be accessible in Lite Mode** in the current Agama v0.6.1 release being used, and also in the new Agama v0.6.1 season 4 release; *And we note again that most of the new ilien coin users generally appear to utilise Agama Lite wallets;*
2. For users running **Verus Coin in Native mode** in their current Agama v0.6.1 wallet release – these users need to download the new Verus Wallet, to continue Native mode use for same; **No version of Agama Native wallet will support Verus Coin from the 14th June 2020;** For **Verus Native** mode users, please link to the Verus wallet update requirements at <https://veruscoin.io/wallet> – which are deemed “mandatory” by June 14th 2020; The following is a quote from Verus discord #announcements from 10th June 2020: *“MAKE SURE TO UPGRADE (VERUS WALLET) BY JUNE 14TH, OR YOU MAY NEED TO RESYNCHRONIZE THE (VERUS) BLOCKCHAIN IF YOU ARE RUNNING IN (VERUS) NATIVE MODE”*

Quick Note to avoid a possible confusion, if a user is upgrading to Agama v0.6.1 season 4:

1. Pursuant to the ilien white paper – the ilien project did not ever envisage having to upgrade open source wallet code, for any wallet which has ILN coin listed, and as such a github repository was not a requirement; Thus whilst the Agama upgrade version is called “Agama v0.6.1 season 4”, this upgrade version has not been added to any github repository; And some thought went into the name for this small app upgrade – and the

season 4 reference, reflects the 4th season of elected komodo notary node operators, as referred to above;

2. As the ilien project is not in the business of holding open source code repositories, a confusion could arise, which we highlight now – when a user downloads and runs the upgrade, namely “Agama v0.6.1 season 4”, the upgrade app will open up as “Agama v0.6.1”, as before; Thus it is essential, that any short cut links, a user makes/creates on their desktop to the upgraded wallet app - they should create a name for the new app in their desktop shortcut that reflects the upgraded app; We suggest calling your upgrade shortcut “Agama v0.6.1 S4”; This is obviously to avoid confusion between the “old” version vs the “new” upgraded version of the agama app; We hope this makes sense;

In closing, many thanks to all in this effort in the last few days, particularly Oink; All who at very short notice “jigsawed” a solution for the ilien community, for the Komodo Daemon upgrade occurring on Sunday the 14th June 2020; And thanks in advance to Chainmakers who will make the necessary ilien server upgrades on Saturday 13th June 2020; We also welcome on behalf of the ilien community, the new Komodo notary node operators – as it is these folk that provide the essential confirmations for ilien transactions, on the ilien blockchain;

Finally, and as mentioned above, a link to the wallet upgrade “**Agama v0.6.1 season 4**” for agama wallet NATIVE users, will be posted in ilien discord #wallets later this evening or Saturday, (and the same link will be posted on the ilien website at <https://ilien.io/#wallet>, over the weekend also); If users have queries reach out to @cathar on ilien discord #wallets, or private/direct message him on the same forum;
